- Air infiltration/exfiltration
- Base load usage
- Conductive heat loss
- Heating appliance
- Heating distribution
- Health and safety issues
- Indoor air quality tests
- Ventilation
- Insulation
- Air sealing
- Refrigerator testing and/or replacement
- Check and/or replace water heater
- Install LED bulbs, pipe wrap, water heater wrap, faucet aerators and shower heads
- Window and door replacements for mobile homes
- Window air conditioners for customers with a medical need



NYSHCR guidelines state that if your home was weatherized at least 15 years ago, it is possible to have your home re-weatherized!

ENERGY SERVICES FEE FOR SERVICE PROGRAM

Listed below are the services that we now provide to the community! These services do not require income guideline eligibility.

- Whole House Energy Audit with test results:
 - ⇒ \$900 up to 2,000 square feet (please call for pricing on larger homes)
- We test and/or evaluate the following:
 - * Heating system and distribution
 - * Air leakage and insulation
 - * Refrigerator, lighting, ventilation and health & safety issues
 - * BTU per square foot per heating degree day pre and post test figures



- Blower Door test only with air change calculation and computer print out: \$750
- Attic insulation (open blow):
 - ⇒ Blown in cellulose insulation
 - ◇ 6" cellulose insulation: \$1.95 per square foot (includes material and labor)
 - ◇ 12" cellulose insulation: \$2.95 per square foot (includes material and labor)
- We do minor repairs, correct health & safety issues, air sealing, refrigerator testing and energy related education

How does the program work?

1. An application is submitted to the local service provider to determine program eligibility;
2. An energy audit of the home is conducted to identify needs;
3. The home weatherized; and
4. Home is inspected to assure quality of work completed.
